**Elizabeth Hargrave** late of Swineshead, Widow, for receiving 7 fowls worth 10 pence belonging to **Elizabeth Crunkhorn** at Swineshead which she knew to be stolen on 12 December 1782.

**Sarah** wife of **Shepherd Smith** late of Swineshead, Blacksmith, for an assault on **Dorothy Whitehead** at Swineshead on 29 July 1792.

**William Everitt** the younger of Swineshead, Labourer, for an assault on **Francis Sewell** at Swineshead on 3 October 1791.

**John Milnes** late of Swineshead, Labourer, and **James Battie** late of Swineshead, Labourer, for 2 assaults on **Aaron Motley** at Swineshead on 3 October 1786.

**George Hides** late of Swineshead, Farmer, for erecting a hedge in the common footway leading from **Benjamin Muggleston & Thomas Wrouth**'s houses at Swineshead to the parochial church at Swineshead and thereby causing a stoppage on 5 April 1779.

**Ann Thorpe** late of Swineshead, Widow, indicted for an assault on **Sarah Bird** of Swineshead on 16 October 1772.
