

The testament of T. Knyght [of Swineshead].

23 January, 1531–2. I Thomas Knyght of Swyneshed make my testament concernyng my last will. My body to be buryed in the church yerde of our Lady in Swyneshed. To the altare ther for tithys forgottyn *xijd.* To every altare in the sayd churche *iiijd.* To the church warke ther *iijs. iiijd.* To our Lady warkes of Lincoln *viiijd.* To the fatherles chylder of s^t Catheryns *viiijd.* The resydue of my goodes I gyff to the disposicion of Richerde Barlyman my father in law, he to gyff and dispose them as he thynkes best. Thes whytnes, sir Thomas Garton vicar; Thomas Dykonson; Richerd Sherpe; cum aliis.
