Declaration

by W<sup>m</sup>. Elizabeth or Eliza Harris  
of Swineshead in the County of Lincoln  
Widow in support of the Heirship  
of her son George William Harris.

I Elizabeth Harris of Swineshead in the County  
of Lincoln Widow do hereby  
solemnly and sincerely declare as follows.

1. On the thirteenth day of March One thousand eight hundred and fifty one I then Eliza Boys Spinster duly intermarried with William Pickles Harris of Swineshead aforesaid Bachelor at the Parish Church of Swineshead aforesaid and I and my said husband are the same persons as "Eliza Boys" and "William Harris" mentioned in the certificate now produced and marked "A" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Marriages kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
2. That I had eight children only by my said husband namely William Henry, Hannah Rebecca, Sarah Eliza, John, Elizabeth Ann, Georgiana, George William, and John Henry.
3. That our Son the said William Henry Harris was born at Swineshead aforesaid on the Fifth day of March One thousand eight hundred and fifty two and died on the Twentyninth day of June One thousand eight hundred and sixty and was buried at Swineshead aforesaid on the Second day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty and he is the same person as "William Henry Harris" mentioned in the Two certificates now produced and marked B and C respectively and which purport to be extracts from the Registers of Births and Burials respectively kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
4. That our Daughter Sarah Eliza now the Wife of Joseph Burden was born on the First day of June One thousand eight hundred and fifty four at Swineshead aforesaid and she is the same person as "Sarah Eliza Harris" mentioned in the certificate now produced and marked "D" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Births kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
5. That our Son John Harris was born on the Fourth day of January One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven at Swineshead aforesaid and died on the Fourth day of May One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight and was buried at Swineshead aforesaid on the Ninth day of May One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight and he is the same person as "John Harris" mentioned in the two Certificates now produced and marked E and F and which purport to be respectively extracts from the Registers of Births and Burials kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
6. That our Daughter Hannah Rebecca now the Wife of Isaac Eaton was born

- on the twentieth day of June One thousand eight hundred and sixty at Swineshead aforesaid and she is the same person as "Hannah R. Harris" mentioned in the Certificate now produced and marked "G" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Births kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
7. That our daughter Elizabeth Ann Harris was born on the twentieth day of June One thousand eight hundred and sixty two at Swineshead aforesaid and is the same person as "Elizabeth Ann Harris" mentioned in the Certificate now produced and marked "H" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Births kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
8. That our Daughter Georgiana Pickles Harris was born on the Twentysecond day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty four at Swineshead aforesaid and is the same person as "Georgiana Pickles Harris" mentioned in the Certificate now produced and marked "I" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Births kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
9. That our son George William Harris was born on the eleventh day of December One thousand eight hundred and sixty six and was baptized at Heckington on the Twentyseventh day of January One thousand eight hundred and sixty seven and he is the same person as "George William Harris" mentioned in the Certificate now produced and marked "K" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Baptisms kept for the said Parish of Heckington.
10. That our son John Henry Harris was born at Swineshead aforesaid on the Twentysecond day of March One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine and is the same person as "John Henry Harris" mentioned in the Certificate now produced and marked "L" and which purports to be an extract from the Register of Births kept for the said Parish of Swineshead.
11. That my husband the said William Pickles Harris died on the Twentyeighth day of December One thousand eight hundred and eighty seven at Swineshead aforesaid intestate and leaving the said George William Harris his eldest surviving son & heir at law.
12. That letters of Administration of the Personal Estate of the said William Pickles Harris were granted to me as his lawful Widow and relict out of the Lincoln District Registry of the Probate Division of Her Majesty's High Court of Justice on the Twentyseventh day of March One thousand eight hundred and eighty eight.

And I make this Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and in pursuance of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
